- •Bhai Muhkam Singh Discipline and Serenity
 - •Barber From Bidar, aged 32 when baptised. Died in the battle of Chamkaur 1704
- •Bhai Sahib Singh Leadership
 - •Water carrier from Jagannath Puri, aged 39. Died in the battle of Chamkaur
